Investing in Illinois: A Nicor Gas System Improvement Initiative is a multi-year initiative to modernize aging natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas, with its contractor KS Energy, has been working to modernize the system that delivers natural gas safely and reliably to your neighborhood and we want to keep you informed of the status of our work. Highlighted below are the major steps involved in the project that are in progress in your neighborhood.

Our Progress

Nicor Gas, with its contractor KS Energy, is in the process of completing the installation of a new natural gas main in your neighborhood. After the new natural gas main is installed, we will be working to install new natural gas lines which will connect each customer's property to the natural gas main.

Completing Our Work: Appointment Required to Connect the System

Nicor Gas' contractor, KS Energy, will install a new natural gas line that connects your property to the natural gas main. Utilities may again be marked with spray paint and flags. Nicor Gas or KS Energy will contact you to schedule an appointment to move your meter outside of your home if it is currently inside.

Due to current weather conditions, we will not be able to connect your property to the new natural gas main without making an appointment. If you are unable to be home during the time of this work, we ask that you please designate a family member, who is at least 18 years of age, to be present at your home so that KS Energy can complete this important work. Once the new natural gas lines have been installed, we will begin to retire the old system.

Completing Our Work

We understand that you value the appearance of your property. Nicor Gas is currently utilizing temporary restoration to ensure that all areas affected by construction are safe for residents as we work to finish the project. We anticipate this work to continue through the rest of 2018 and into 2019. Permanent restoration will be completed once this project is finished. We apologize for the inconvenience but please know that we are committed to restoring the street and parkway to the same or better condition than when the project started.

For Your Safety

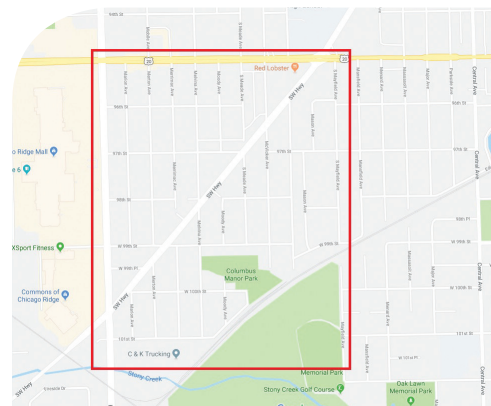
