







Weatherization rebates for multi-family buildings



Available from January 1 - December 31, 2025

Air seal and insulate your way to savings with weatherization rebates for your multi-family property. If your building has drafts or air quality concerns, these improvements can help save money and energy for you and your

<p>AIR SEALING</p>  <p>Air sealing is the first thing you do to close gaps and hole that cause constant air leaks in your building. This must be done before adding insulation.</p> <p>Rebate: \$2 per linear foot</p>	<p>ATTIC INSULATION</p>  <p>Adding insulation to your attic minimizes heat loss during the winter and prevents heat from entering your building during the summer.</p> <p>Rebate: Up to \$2.50 per square foot</p>
<p>DOOR SWEEPS</p>  <p>Install door sweeps along the bottom edge of exterior doors to seal the gap between the door and the frame and prevent heating and cooling loss.</p> <p>Rebate: \$75 per exterior door</p>	<p>DOOR WEATHERSTRIPPING</p>  <p>Install door weatherstripping around exterior doors to close gaps between the door and door frame using weatherstripping.</p> <p>Rebate: \$25 per exterior door</p>
<p>DUCT SEALING</p>  <p>Duct sealing minimizes the air lost due to leaks, holes and poor connection in your duct work.</p> <p>Rebate: \$500 per building</p>

- Reduce drafts and air leaks, helping improve temperature control to keep your tenants comfortable all year long
- Increase HVAC efficiency and reduce wasted energy
- Lower heating and cooling costs
- Improve overall air quality in your building

- Reduce noise from the outside
- Achieve a sustainable future by lowering (GHG) emissions
